

Day 2: 13th Leonora Golden Wheels and inaugural Leonora Women's Classic

Sunday 2 June 2024 – 104km

No Licence, No Race: All Goldfields Cyclassic Race entrants must hold a current AusCycling – 'Race All Disciplines Licence.' No other licences are accepted for the Cyclassic Race. Click <u>HERE</u> to purchase your licence. You will need to show proof of purchase of your licence at Registration.

Grade winners of Day 1 may be reallocated to other grades for Day 2 races.

MALE RIDERS: Leonora Golden Wheels

Male Riders will complete the 103km from Menzies to Leonora in Graded Scratch Races, each grade racing separately for line honours in the Leonora Golden Wheels. A Grade men will be first to start from the Shire of Menzies Town Hall.

Sprints

There will be one sprint only for the Scratch Races awarded to each grade at the Gibraltar Rock sprint at 65km, sponsored by to be advised.

FEMALE RIDERS: Leonora Women's Classic

The inaugural Women's Classic is a handicap race from Menzies to Leonora. Starting at the Menzies Town Hall.

There are three sprints along the way with the first female across the line at each point winning a Jersey and prize money.

1000: Leonora Women's Classic Race start. D to A Grade

1100 to 1330: Riders arrive in Leonora.

1230 to 1430: Riders return transponder to Registration desk, pack bikes and bags (car park area in Otterburn St). Showers available at the Leonora Aquatic Centre on Tower Street. Please ensure you have a towel.

1430: Leonora Criterium. The elite A Grade males and invited others will take to the streets of Leonora for the fast and furious 30-minute Leonora Criterium Race. Highlighting the sport of cycling to spectators and Leonora Gift competitors, this action-packed format is a new initiative and terrific way to close out the weekend's racing.

Approximately 1600: Presentation for Overall Cyclassic winners – Track Side Stage in Tower Street

Approximately 1630: Leonora Golden Wheels and Leonora Women's Classic Awards of Stage, Grade and Sprint prizes will take place at the Garden Bar, Central Hotel, Tower Street. Complimentary refreshments and finger food will be provided.

1800: Board bus located in Otterburn St to catch Alliance Airlines flight back to Perth

1815: Board the bus back to Kalgoorlie-Boulder
